Mr. Dammeier - a founding and now managing partner of **Lackie, Dammeier & McGill** - started in law enforcement work as a police officer for the City of Cypress subsequently moving to the police department of Claremont, California - where he was elected to the Police Officer's Association taking on responsibilities in labor-management issues. He attended Western State University School of Law graduating in the top 5% of his class in 1996. He continued in police work as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff for San Bernardino County. Mr. Dammeier is a member of the State Bar of California. He practices in all of the State and Federal courts with a focus on police officer issues. He has appeared before State legislative communities and participated in drafting *SB 1516* which imposes a monetary penalty against management violation of an officer's rights under the Public Safety Officers Procedural Bill of Rights Act. Mr. Dammeier has argued cases at every judicial level, including the California and United States Supreme Courts and is co-author of the *Pocket Guide to the Public Safety's Officers Procedural Bill of Rights Act*.
