PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

Before beginning the application process, please read the entire application packet. Applications are accepted as early as July 1 prior to the start of the following academic year. Applications will be accepted until the end of the spring term for that academic year.

President's Scholarship:

Established to encourage diversity within the student body, the President's Scholarships are available to all students with educationally or economically disadvantaged backgrounds. Scholarships are awarded per academic year. When the scholarship award has expired, students are encouraged to re-apply. Two distinct awards are available:

- Partial scholarship
- Full Scholarship

Eligibility Information:

To be considered for scholarships, you must submit both an Application for Admission and the Scholarship Application. Competition for scholarships is very strong. Unless exceptional circumstances exist, scholarship recipients are required to achieve and maintain a 2.65 or better cumulative grade point average in first-year classes and a 3.0 G.P.A. or better cumulative grade point average in the remaining years of courses. Failure to maintain the required G.P.A.'s will result in the automatic and permanent forfeiture of the award.

Criterion:

The Scholarship Committee selects recipients from application's personal statements addressing their background, hardships, achievements & financial need. Previous academic performance is also a criterion.
